



If you have a tablet you can borrow digital library books using the Overdrive app. Overdrive is a Rakuten company that offers this service for free. This is how it works:

- Download the Overdrive app from your device's app store.
- Open the OverDrive app and follow the prompts to sign in (or sign up) using your library card, Facebook, or a free Overdrive account.
- Using www.overdrive.com, open the San Bernardino County Library's digital collection
- Find a Kindle Book to borrow.
- Select Borrow
- Find the ebook you've borrowed on your Check-outs page (under your Account).
